



Zipper Loop Instructions

1. Thread the cord supplied with your Phoenix-Fly suit through the upper zip as shown.



2. Loosely tie a single overhand knot keeping both ends level.



3. Tighten the knot, leaving around a fingers width from the knot to the ends of the cord. This should give you around 7cm from the knot to the zipper.



4. Rotate the loop you have made so the knot is at one side.



5. Pinch the end of the loop together and thread it through the hole in the end of the lower zipper tab.



6. Take the knot and thread it through the end of the loop.



7. Pull the cord in between the zips to tighten the loop, locking the knot in place on the lower zipper.



8. Once tightened this should allow around 10cm spacing between the zippers, if you tied the overhand knot in the right place (step 2. & 3.). For shorter spacing move the knot closer to the upper zip. For wider spacing move the knot further away.



9. To undo simply push the cord back through the lower zipper, slackening the loop, and unthread. There is no need to undo the overhand knot - next time start from step 5.
